## General Understanding

Tennis may be played without regard to Vaccination Status.

Clubhouses may be used as long as limited to directly supporting the Community Sporting Activity; therefore this does not ‘cross over’ to the supply of food and drink.

Toilet facilities available and are exempt from all restrictions relating to vaccination status.

Once a tennis venue additionally provides food and drink supplies, patrons are required to be fully vaccinated as per Hospitality Venues’. A Covid Marshal needs to confirm vaccination status.

Where food and drink services are supplied in a commercial setting (ie. for a fee), measures are required to do this in a Covid Safe manner. Eg. Common or shared cutlery and serving arrangements are to be avoided. Buffet arrangements are to be avoided. Service is to be provided direct to individual patrons.

## ELTC Implementation

Where ELTC does not check vaccination status, the Clubhouse is not to be open other than the Tournament Box (not for patrons, Staff only) and the Toilets. No food or bar facility provided.

For Tournaments, Night Tennis and Saturday Afternoon Tennis, the Clubhouse Bar (outside window to decking) will be used for food and/or drinks service. Therefore only fully vaccinated patrons (participants and spectators) are allowed at the event and venue.

Junior Tennis will be conducted without wider Clubhouse use (ie. Toilets only). It will continue to operate without regard to vaccination status of players and spectators. This is done to allow for the change to 12+ year old vaccination restrictions. Once advice is received from Junior Conveners that our participants have had the opportunity to meet the 90% restrictions, this event will become one requiring double vaccination. This will allow for Clubhouse access and hospitality (eg. a BBQ).

In summary; apart from casual attendees outside of competition formats, and our Junior Competition (until advised); ELTC requires players and spectators to be fully vaccinated. Measures providing for the strict adherence to “Proof of Vaccination” will be in place.
