Open Events and Round Robin Tournament (minimum 3 sets)

The Tournament is played on 14 lawn courts (and 6 mod. grass courts may also be used). Catering for meals and refreshments is provided throughout the tournament.

All events are round robin except for the Men's and Women's Open Singles which will be best of three 6 game sets.

The Tournament is conducted over three days. Men's and Women's Graded Singles are scheduled on Saturday. Men's and Women's Graded Doubles are played on Sunday and the Graded Mixed Doubles are held on Monday. The Open events are conducted over the three days with finals on the Monday. Graded events are completed on the one day, where possible, with presentation of trophies each evening upon completion of play.

The format is round robin with a minimum of 3 sets per event - section finals will be conducted. The exceptions are the Men's and Women's Open Singles which are knock-out events - best of 3, 6 game tie-breaker sets.
2. Each competitor must fill in an entry form, EVEN IF PLAYING IN DOUBLES ONLY.	8. Please note D Grade is for beginning players and other players who are placed at the lowest level of club competition.
3. Players may only enter in one event per day except Junior Singles entrants who may also play in the Open Singles.	9. Approximate times of play for the Singles Events will be displayed on the website and in the Clubrooms after 5.00pm on Friday.
4. VTA State Section 1 & 2 Pennant players or equivalent, are eligible for Open events only.	10. The date for determination of junior age events is MARCH 31, 2012.
5. Except for Open, A Grade and Age events, previous year's winners must enter a higher event.	11. The Committee reserves the right to cancel events, combine events, reject or regrade entries and reduce the length of matches as it deems necessary.
6. Players entered in A, B and C Grade events are ineligible to play in lower grade events.	12. Players are required at the courts from 8.30am each morning. Approximate times for matches will be posted at the Clubhouse late the previous evening.
