

#### TOURNAMENT CONDITIONS

\*\*\*Please read prior to on-line entry\*\*\*

If a dispute occurs during a match and cannot be resolved amicably, you or your opponent may suspend play and must then immediately contact a member of the Tournament Committee for a binding ruling.



- 1. Close of entries will be notified via our Tournament Website based on a cap of 550 players
- 2. Entry fees are to be paid at time of entry. Unpaid entries not accepted. Refunds cannot be given for withdrawals after match times are published.
- 3. Prize money of \$1,000 (winner) and \$250 (runner-up) is awarded for Men's and Women's Open Singles events. If the event is not commenced, money will not be awarded and entry fees will be refunded. Where an event is partially completed, the prize pool will be distributed to players not eliminated.
- 4. The date for determination of junior age events is MARCH 31, 2025.
- 5. All competitors must enter via the online portal. DOUBLES pairings will require BOTH PLAYERS to enter and pay online.
- 6. Players may only enter in one singles, doubles and mixed event.
- 7. The Committee reserves the right to cancel events, combine events, reject or regrade entries and reduce the length of matches as it deems necessary. Open singles events may become round robin subject to numbers of entries.
- 8. Grading Advice...

Tennis Victoria Grade 2 Pennant players and above or equivalent are eligible for Open events only. Please note, D Grade is for beginning players and other players who are placed at the lowest level of club competition. Doubles pairings are graded to the higher standard player. Previous year's event winners must enter a higher event, except for winners of Open, A Grade and Junior events.

- 9. Men's and Women's Open Singles are knock-out events best of 3, (6 game tie-breaker sets, third set where required is played as a 10 point tiebreak). For other events, the format is round robin with a minimum of 3 sets per event. Where an event includes more than one division, knockout finals will be played.
- 10. Times of play for all round robin events will be displayed on the website prior to commencement of the tournament. First match times for Open Singles events also displayed. SMS updates regarding match times and tournament advice are sent to mobiles.

- 11. Players are required at the courts and ready to play 30 minutes prior to their scheduled match times.
